

Communion Assistants

1. Please gown using one of the albs available.
2. The communion assistant may sit in the front row during the announcements, prelude, and confession, then come up to the front with the pastor following the confession. If there is a procession, the communion assistant make come to the front with the pastor.
3. The communion assistant should be ready to lead those prayers and parts marked with "A" for assistant. It may be helpful to mark then in your bulletin prior to the service.
4. If there is no acolyte, the communion assistant should hand out the offering plates.
5. The communion assistant should receive the communion elements brought forward and set up the altar for the pastor, including pouring wine into the cup, about 2/3 full.
6. The communion assistant will say "the Blood of Christ shed for you" or similar words as the communicant dips the bread into the cup.
7. The communion assistant will leave the chancel area with the pastor during the final hymn.
