Summer Lutheran Cluster Service on Sunday, August 4th. Join our neighboring churches for worship - Advent (Harleysville), Little Zion (Telford), Christ (Kulpsville), Emmanuel (Souderton), and St. Paul's (Telford). The six cluster churches will worship together at Emmanuel Lutheran in Souderton at 10 am. Rev. Dr. Nelson Rivera will lead an Adult Bible Study at 9 am titled: "For I was a stranger, and you welcomed me' (Matt 25:35) A Christian Response to the Immigration."
