Communion Choice: White grape juice is available for you to choose during communion. The white grape juice is in small communion cups in a silver tray on a table located at the right front row of chairs near the altar. As you approach the altar you may take a glass from the tray with you to the altar. When the chalice is brought to you, you drink the cup of grape juice. Please return empty cups to the empty side of the tray.

"Word of note regarding music: For Reformation Sunday and All Saints, we will sing the Canticle of Praise "This is the Feast". In addition the choir may enter worship in Procession and lead the first half of Worship from the music area with Kevin. We will also begin to learn a newer setting of the Liturgy that is melodic, easy to learn, flexible on either the piano or organ, and can creatively inspire singing. Kevin promises to introduce parts of this Liturgy by pacing it over several weeks and by the New Year, helping it feel familiar as a nice addition to worship."
