- 1. The challenge of John the Baptist: *Bear fruit worthy of repentance!* Show that you mean it, if you say you're sorry or that you want to change! Have you ever needed to make this kind of change in your life? What gave you the courage? Or the strength?
- 2. For what do you hope in this season?
- 3. Does your heart long to repent of something? To turn away from something? Are you looking for some kind of new life?
