Lou Farrell invites Grace members and friends to make sandwiches for members of the Welcome Church, a Lutheran congregation in Philadelphia, many of whose members are unsheltered. All Welcome Church activities, including worship, have been suspended for now, as well as many feeding programs where Welcome Church members usually eat.

Lou and Cathy Farrell have committed to providing sandwiches through the office of Homeless Services in Philadelphia each Wednesday. They invite us to join them. We are going to try for the week after Easter on Tuesday, April 14th with the possibility of continuing if sandwich makers among us want to respond.

Here's Lou's challenge to us:

- You make peanut butter and jelly sandwiches on white bread and put them in ZIPLOC bags, 1 sandwich per bag. Use cheap white bread with gobs of PB and J. A loaf will get you nine sandwiches. Please consider buying two loaves.
- Make the kind of sandwiches that your Mom used to yell at you about. Load them up. We want to fill bellies.
- Lou and Cathy will leave a cooler with ice outside Grace's entrance all day on Tuesday. Leave your donation in the labeled cooler sometime between 8:00 am and 8:00 pm on Tuesday, April 14th.
- Please email Lou to let him know how many sandwiches you made. He'll deliver Wednesday.
