PB & J Sandwich Update: Welcome Bread

With the counties in our region moving to Yellow, Project HOME in Philadelphia, which provided the Outreach workers who distributed all of our sandwiches, has changed their policies. They are willing to receive a much more limited supply from us, which has caused us to spread out our own distribution, effective this past week. We want to take this moment to explain where we are after about 2 months of the project.

We are continuing to supply Project HOME in Philadelphia, which serves members of the Welcome Church. We provide to the food cupboards in Hatfield. But with the reduction in the number distributed through Project HOME, we have now also found new distribution points for our beloved PB & J.

We are now distributing sandwiches weekly to Emmanuel Souderton's daily distribution food program, and to St. Stephen's Episcopal Church's food programs in Norwood and Folcroft Borough (Delaware County).

A dozen other churches of 3 denominations have joined with Grace on this project, in addition to Angels Sharing the Warmth in Telford, and a number of unaffiliated people. Last week, together we created together 2,540 sandwiches and 140 snack bags. About 1,000 sandwiches regularly come on Grace's Tuesday collection day: WOW!

Doors are opening before us and hungry people everywhere love our sandwiches.

Giving Update

Last month, a letter went out to everyone who had given in the first 4 months of the year. Since not everyone receiving these *Grace Notes* is a weekly or monthly donor to Grace, we wanted to quote a few paragraphs of that letter here, for a wider distribution, to let you know how Grace is managing financially in these difficult times.

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. I thank my God every time I remember you... Philippians 1:2-3a

May 21, 2020

Dear Grace Family,

Our lives have been turned upside down since we were last able to gather for worship on March 8th. While we and Council members, and other ministry leaders have been able to be in touch with many of you, we do not know how all of you are faring in this time of great upheaval. We pray that you are well, that you have everything you need, that you are safe if you need to be out in the community working, and that you are able to occupy yourselves fruitfully, if you are sheltering in place. If there are ways we may be able to assist you, especially with food, with conversation or with prayer, we hope you will let us know

We pause to send the first giving statement of the year, as we do after Easter each year, and to share some ministry highlights with you.

In the midst of all the turmoil, we have needed to make such drastic changes in how we operate. At least for now, we were excited to review the financial reports at Council this week to see increased congregational giving in March and April as compared to January and February. While giving has continued, our General Giving through April year-to-date is behind budget (\$43,800 versus a budgeted amount of \$55,000). Additionally, with Stepping Stones closed we are not currently collecting a Fair Share payment. On the other hand, we have benefited from lower expenses so far this year which means our current year deficit is only \$3,000, which is an improvement from where we were through April of last year.

PB & J Sandwiches, Instructions

- You make peanut butter and jelly sandwiches on soft *white* bread and put them in ZIPLOC bags, 1 sandwich per bag. Use cheap white bread with gobs of PB and J. A loaf will get you nine sandwiches. Please consider buying two loaves.
- The cooler will be at the entrance to Grace all day each TUESDAY. Leave your donation in the labeled coolers between 8:00 am and 8:00 pm
