Welcome Bread: PB & J Sandwiches

Jenny, our mascot and office puppy over here at Welcome Bread World Headquarters would like to thank you for your hard work and give everyone an update. (See this full update and other Welcome Bread news on the Welcome Bread Facebook page.)

In 11 weeks, we have delivered just under 16,000 PB&Js to our partners who then get them out to hungry people. We have also delivered 1,127 snack bags, 100 hygiene kits, 9 woven sleeping mats and numerous cases of bananas and clementines.

I split the driving with our friend Barry Haydt and his crew of roughneck grand kids.

In this short time, we have expanded the operation so that we support folks in Souderton, Hatfield, Lansdale, Kensington, Hunting Park, North Philly, Center City, Upper Darby, Folcroft, Norwood, Chester and East Lansdowne. We have almost 70 people working on Welcome Bread. You are doing important work. Hungry people are being fed.

Council Supports Worship & Music recommendations that Grace return to in-person worship, beginning on Sunday, July 5th. Governor Wolf recently announced that Montgomery County will move to Green on Friday, June 26th; waiting until the next weekend follows the recommendation of Bishop Davenport that congregations of the synod wait until July to return to in-person worship and gives us time to prepare. There will be one service at 9:15 am OUTSIDE, weather permitting (bad weather moving inside, called at 4 pm on Saturday.) Safety precautions will be in place.
