We'll be waiting a while to return to flowers, as we will be outside.

We may be taking photos or video recordings during Grace Events. You will be giving your consent that any pictures and/or video taken may be published and/or distributed by Grace Lutheran Church (i.e. Facebook, website, promotional materials) by attending these events. *Please let Pastor Peterman, or a Church Council member, know if you would prefer that you and/or your child's image not be used.* 

Council will call a congregational meeting in August to deal with resolutions coming out of the Bible studies about sexuality and pastoral ministry in the next pastoral tenure, including whether gay and lesbian weddings will be permitted in the sanctuary.

When the resolutions are prepared, a first-class letter will be sent to all congregational members. For now, Council is trying to determine the best date when the most people would be able to attend. The Bishop and Deans of the synod have just opened up some possibilities for holding congregational meetings again after not permitting them earlier. We are looking at Sundays, August 23<sup>rd</sup> or 30<sup>th</sup>, after worship.

If at all possible, our meeting will be held outside, weather permitting, following worship that day. (The sound is working well!) You may express your date choice. at survey papers available in worship on July 12th and 19th, which forms are also attached to these electronic *Grace Notes*. This is the last step before submitting the Ministry Site Profile (MSP) to launch the call process.

ELCA Lutheran congregational constitutions do NOT permit absentee or proxy voting, even in Covid time. Deadline is Sunday, July 19<sup>th</sup> for participating in the survey. It's helpful also for us to know if you feel you can't participate because of the virus.



#### Sheltered in the shade!

Each Saturday at 4 pm, leaders and staff decide if the weather is good enough to be outside for worship, which many at Grace have said they feel is safer. If we should decide on a particular weekend that we'll need to move indoors, we'll send out an email by 5 pm on Saturday evening. Barring weather emergencies – hail, an unexpected thunderstorm – we'll stick with that decision so you can know what to expect. Please pass the word along to others who do not receive church email.
