From the Executive Committee:

Your Executive Committee of Council and Worship & Music leaders and staff continue their ongoing discussion about Grace's continuing to hold in person worship services in light of the surge of virus cases around us. We have decided, for now, to try to continue having them as long as possible. We believe that we have developed appropriate protocols that members have taken personal responsibility and, if they are at risk, they stay at home. We know that the people who come for services really need the human contact that is offered there.

We will be a bit more insistent about moving people along after the services, though. At this time, in person Christmas services are still planned.

As we all know, a new governor's order, or new Montgomery County regulations could cause us to reevaluate our plans. We ask for your continued prayers: for front line workers; for those working in medical settings; for all working for cures and with the vaccines; for Grace's staff and leaders; and for all who struggle with isolation and fear.

Grace and Heidelberg combine for Thanksgiving Eve:

All VIRTUAL this year! Join us in praise, and in remembering your gratitude, in spite of all of 2020's challenges. And you are in for some musical treats, thanks to Kevin's work with Grace's choir and his preparing a recital for the service.

At the conclusion of the service, Kevin prepared a "virtual pipe organ concert" featuring 6 organs from around the world, including the USA! Kevin recommends that if you have headphones or earbuds, you will be able to hear the sounds with more clarity. The concert will include Thanksgiving hymn-based preludes and postludes, some of Kevin's own hymn arrangements on familiar tunes and then a couple pieces that you might not hear other than in concert, but the program concludes with one of the most famous organ Toccatas from the 5th Organ Symphony by Charles-Marie Widor, a French composer and organist.

EEC Food Cupboard UPDATES...

Every week your generous donations feed a growing number of people in Hatfield who are finding it necessary to get their household supplies and food from the EEC food cupboard. Thank you so much for continuing to drop off donations in our plastic food bins located under the portico at Grace, as well as in the food bins in the narthex. Any additional items you can pick up while you shop will make a difference. Updated wish lists for scarce items will be shared in Grace notes. Janet Hague shared the October

figures: 2,560 lbs. of food distributed to 45 families (155 individuals, 1/3 of them children

The items that are currently in the most need:

- Gift cards Janet can shop for exactly what is needed
- Canned Vegetables: asparagus, carrots, peas, spinach, lima beans, mixed vegetables, whole tomatoes
- Tuna in oil
- Vinegar pint or quart
- Applesauce Large cans or jars (29-30 oz)
- Pasta, boxed any shape or size except spagetti
- Paper towels
- Toilet paper individually wrapped
- Shampoo
- Body Wash
