

Details for INDOOR services during COVID:

- Do not attend services if you are not feeling well or are particularly at risk for the virus.
- Do not attend services if you have been in contact with anyone that may have the virus.
- Wear a mask and social distance (6 feet).
- Bulletins, Grace Notes and offering baskets will be at both sets of doors to the sanctuary.
- If you would like to use the hearing assist device, please pick them up at the sound system desk. When the service is completed, return devices to the desk, and clean them with the wipes available at the desk.
- We will share the Peace of the LORD safely by remaining at our seats and quietly singing a short verse.
- Communion will be offered twice a month with COVID protocols in place.
- Pastor will not be standing in a greeting spot after the service.
- Bathrooms will be available, and you may enter through the main entrance. We would appreciate that you use a paper towel to open the door as you enter and exit the bathroom. Paper towels will be in the hallway by the bathrooms.
- Hand sanitizer is available at both entrances to the building.
- You will see signs around the building explaining safety procedures.
- Services will be limited to 30 – 40 minutes total, and both singing and responsive readings will be limited.
