As part of the reviews, we worked on goals together for their work for program year 2021-22.



Stepping Stones is a ministry of Grace, in its 51st year! The ministry is in a time of re-building in many ways -- working in an extremely difficult situation this year, Jess has brought the school to nearly full enrollment in daycare (40+ children), from a mixed program with Nursery School before the pandemic. She is also helping church leaders re-build the bridge between church and school, with pen pals between classrooms and homebound members of the congregation who are able to write letters, events involving both, a soon-to-come Adopt-a-grandparent program. Under her leadership, Stepping Stones welcomed infants and young toddlers. She brings joy and passion to all she does.



How grateful we are to have had Kevin lead our music program during this pandemic year. Yes, we have missed singing together! Yet his creativity and flexibility brought us musical gifts we hadn't imagined we might have at Grace: a choir of solo singers combined through the wonders of technology, projected on the wall (but Covid-safe!); a new chimes choir; the wonder of digital transmission of historic organs of Europe through an Allen electronic organ here in

America... and week after week, the faithful, expressive, seasonal playing of hymns to coordinate with the readings of the day to lift our spirits, to minister to us in all the seasons and moods of our lives. Kevin is such a good leader, and a wonderful team player with us for the life of Grace, moving forward.
