The Worship and Music Committee would like you to know about two changes to our worship life that will begin next week.

First, so that the service may begin at the appointed time, we are moving the announcements to near the end of the service, before the Blessing and Dismissal. Kevin's Prelude will then truly be a prelude, starting at around 9:10. Pastor Raabe will now be coordinating the announcements; please let her know if there is something in addition to what's printed in Grace Notes that people need to know about, or whether you would like to come up and share this news yourself at that point in the service. Additional voices are always welcome!

Second, we are moving to the practice of what is called "continuous flow" communion as we work toward our regular practice of standing at the front to receive. As we are all accustomed to keeping distance in line from the person in front of us, we feel this is a safe and efficient practice. As you experience this means of receiving the sacrament, you might also reflect on how it also bears the symbol of a people in exile, "an image consistent throughout Scripture for God's people while on earth," as one pastor has pointed out. "Patriarchs in the Old Testament like Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the children of Israel in the wilderness, John the Baptist in the countryside, the Apostle Paul traveling from church to church in his mission work, and even Jesus himself, who claimed the absence of a real home on earth (Matthew 8:20), are all images that the Holy Spirit inspires in Scripture to remind readers that this home is not a permanent one, but that we walk, united, to our heavenly Promised Land."
