In John 13:34 Jesus gives us "a new commandment: love one another. Just as I have loved you, you must also love one another." There is no better expression of love for neighbor than concern for their well-being. With the Covid risk level steadily increasing in Montgomery County as elsewhere, please remember that certain Covid guidelines remain in effect here at Grace to ensure the safety of all our members and friends:

- Please stay home from church if you feel even slightly ill in any way; watch the service online when it is posted by Wednesday of each week.
- While we are not yet asking you to wear face masks during our church services, we want to remind you of this important safety practice. Your Council and staff are continuing to track the numbers in our area and, if the increase continues to be significant, we may need to return to asking you to wear face coverings. How this will affect our worship life will be evaluated by our Council and Worship and Music Committee with care, compassion, and a desire to invite you into the fullness of worship in whatever way ensures the promise of abundant life for us all. As before, face coverings are required in the building whenever Stepping Stones is in session.
- Please observe social distancing when you are visiting with others in the sanctuary or narthex, and as you are coming forward for communion. The best place to visit with each other continues to be outside!
