Electronic Giving Made Easy!

In these times when in-person attendance has not yet returned to customary levels, we warmly encourage you to consider signing on for secure electronic giving.



- Forms for direct-deposit giving (formerly known as Simply Giving) are on the ledge in the narthex; seal them in an envelope and leave in Tami Sarm's box or on Lynn Fasick's desk. This now includes credit cards.
- ♣ On a computer or laptop, sign on for giving by credit card by going to the Give page of our website. Or give using your mobile device by downloading the free Vanco Mobile app from the App Store or Google Play; search for "Grace Lutheran Hatfield" and follow from there.
- ♣ Or you may give by text message (one time or recurring) simply by texting the amount to our designated number: 844-613-0815.

With the first two options you may designate one of our funds, while giving by text goes directly into the General Fund. For online or mobile giving there is a one-time signup form you must complete. We are now PCI compliant, indicating the highest levels of security.
