committee found various options for an organ but the one found that is perfect for us is from Bethlehem, PA. Its former owner is an 89 year old organist who bought the organ a while back but ended up in a most unfortunate circumstance rendering her unable to play anymore. The organ is a fully complete Allen church organ in pristine condition with lots of new technology. The organ offers unique features that will engage our congregation for years of hymn singing and beautiful music. This week we have started the process to install the organ. It has certain components that will be completed by Easter, but the main console should be up and playing this week or next.
