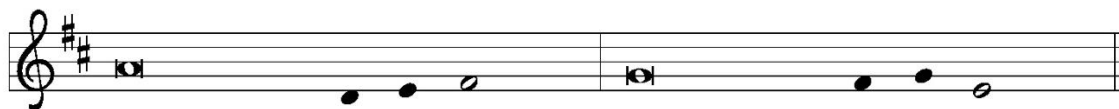
CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS
