## • Pledge Cards

Pledge cards will be mailed to each home and will also be available in church each Sunday. We ask that you prayerfully consider completing a pledge card and return it by Sunday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>. Place your pledge card in the provided envelope and either mail it to the church or place it in the offering basket.

## FAQ's regarding Pledge Cards/Financially Giving:

• What is a Pledge? When a church asks it's members to "pledge", it is seeking a statement of estimated giving intent for the year to come. For each giver, this sets a giving goal for the coming year and assists church leaders in making financial plans for the church and its many ministries.

• How Much is Enough? While the biblical standard of giving is a tithe, it is recognized that it is not possible for everyone. The church encourages you to try 'growth giving' – and increase your giving each year as you are able. We ask that you seek God's guidance and consider the ways we can Glorify God.

• What if I cannot meet my Pledge? – It is understood that circumstances can change throughout the course of the year. You will **never** be contacted about the status of your giving. Giving reports/statements are provided for your information only.

**How is My Privacy Assured?** Use and seal the provided response envelope. Only the Council-appointed Financial Secretary sees submitted pledges and manages a separate system for recording pledges, tracking giving and producing giving reports.

• What if I am not in a Position to make a Financial Pledge? The pledge card offers you the option of committing to supporting Grace Lutheran Church without making a specific dollar amount. This is a personal commitment and states that while there may be uncertainty in your current circumstances, it is your intent to support the church as you can.

• Why does my pledge matter? Our pledge card, regardless of amount, says that "I am a part of a community of Christ, a Child of God". It helps us to put our money where our mission statement is ... To *Glorify God, Grow in Faith, Give in Service, Together in Christ.* 

## • What Ways Can I Give?

• Offering envelopes can be placed in the offering basket on Sunday, mailed, or placed in the mailbox outside the entrance doors

• Simply Giving – Electronically have your offering taken out of your account – you can determine how often and the amounts.
