**that I may rest in peace.**



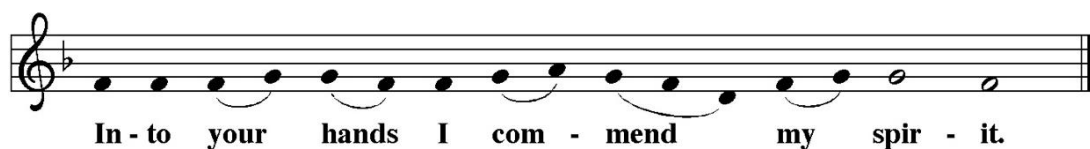
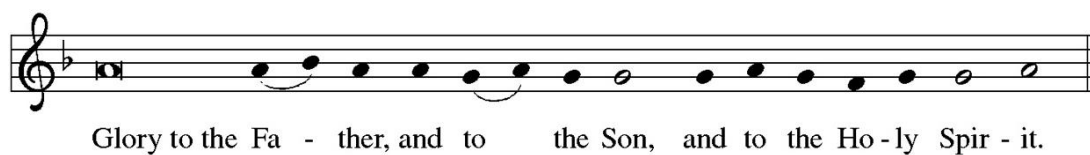
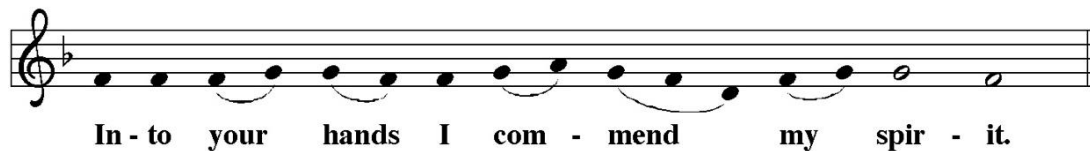
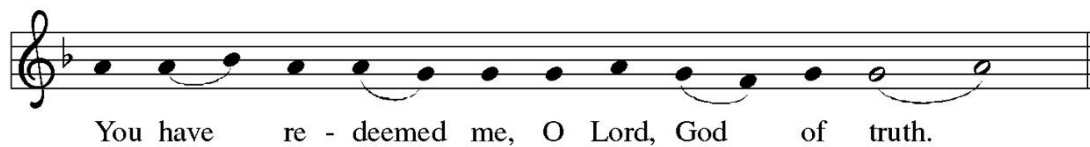
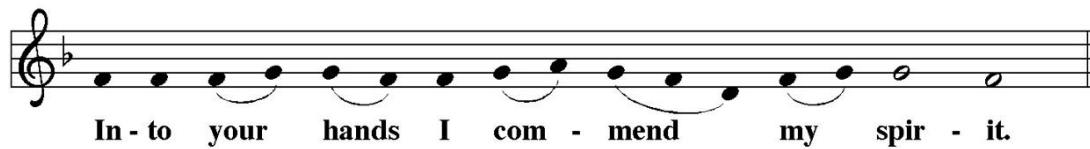
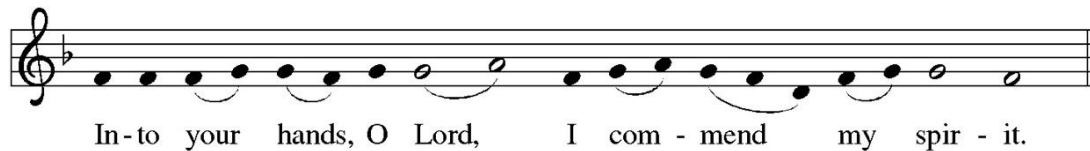
## WORD

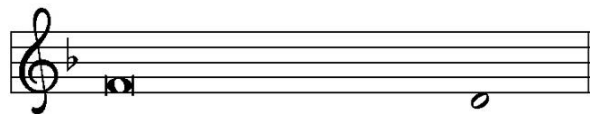
Hear my prayer, O Lord; **listen to my cry.**



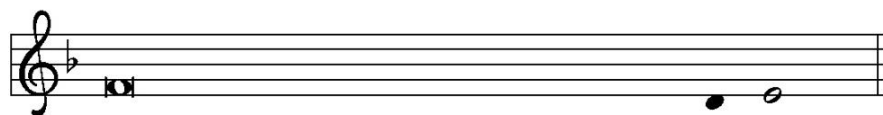
Keep me as the apple of your eye;
