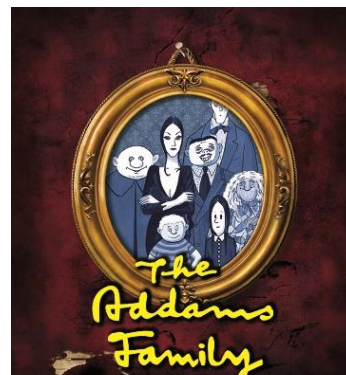
The Addams Family, the musical comedy, is coming to The Laymen Playmen for their 38th production.
